

15 Reasons To Read The Bible Daily

1. **To be rid of anxiety and have peace.** (Ps. 119:165 “Great peace have those who love Your law, and nothing causes them to stumble.”)
2. **To set things right when life is out of control.** (Ps. 19:7-8 “The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul; The testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple; The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; The commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes.”)
3. **To have direction and know God’s will** (Ps. 119:105 “Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.”)
4. **To experience healing and deliverance** (Ps. 107:20 “He sent His word and healed them, And delivered them from their destructions.”)
5. **To grow in the Lord** (1 Peter 2:2 “as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby.”)
6. **To have strength, comfort, and hope** (Ps. 119:28, “My soul melts from heaviness; Strengthen me according to Your word.” 50 “This is my comfort in my affliction, For Your word has given me life.” 114 “You are my hiding place and my shield; I hope in Your word.”)
7. **To shape yourself and your life correctly** (Ps. 119:11 “Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.”)
8. **To be able to see clearly** (Ps. 119:130 “The entrance of Your words gives light; It gives understanding to the simple.”)
9. **To know what’s really in your heart** (Heb. 4:12 “For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.”)
10. **To build faith** (Rom. 10:17 “So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”)
11. **To have joy** (Ps. 16:11 “You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.”)
12. **To understand God’s power** (John 1:3 “All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.”)
13. **To have more life in this life** (Ps. 119:50 “This is my comfort in my affliction, For Your word has given me life.”)
14. **To distinguish good from evil** (Ps. 119:101-2 “I have restrained my feet from every evil way, that I may keep Your word. I have not departed from Your judgments, for You Yourself have taught me.”)
15. **To understand God’s love for you** (John 1:14 “And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.”)
